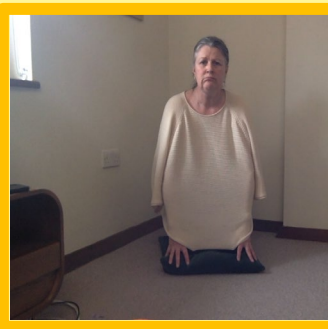

Sunday May 23rd & (or) May 30th - 3-5pm in the Margaret Beaufort Garden

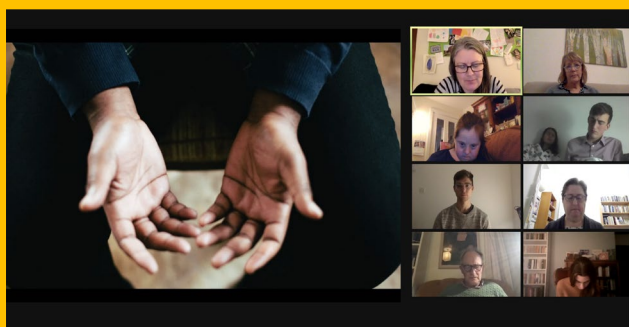
Our first opportunity to begin to gather again in person as a wider community- hallelujah!
